EMPLOYEE EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

Three (3) Scholarships, up to a maximum of \$1,000 each are to be awarded to three individuals who are current employees of a Distributor/Fabricator that is a full member of NIBA-The Belting Association. *Scholarship applications can be made for future or completed courses. Full reimbursement will be paid on presentation of course documentation showing amount paid and grade for courses completed within the previous or future twelve months of award date.*

Criteria of Candidate Eligibility

- Must be a current employee of a NIBA Distributor/Fabricator member company
- Must attend trade schools, professional seminars, Industrial Distribution University, accredited Jr. college, colleges and universities, or NIBA training
- Acceptable subjects will be business- or industry-related courses that the Employer views as an asset to the Industry or the Company or those courses required for a degree.
- Must not be a NIBA director, officer or NIBA committee chairperson or a Member Company's owner with five percent or greater holdings.
